GOD's Eternal Purpose and HIS Full Inheritance

Pray for the Revelation of GOD's Calling, Inheritance and Power to Accomplish His Calling

Ephesians 1:17-23 (NKJV)

17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, **18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened**; that you may know what is **the hope of His calling**, what are **the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints**, **19** and what is **the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe**, according to the working of His mighty power **20** which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, **21** far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. **22** And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, **23** which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

Pray for Strength to Experientially Know and Be Filled with GOD's Fullness

Ephesians 3:16-21 (NKJV)

16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, **to be strengthened with might** through His Spirit in the inner man, **17 that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith**; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, **18** may be **able to comprehend** with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height— **19 to know** the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you **may be filled with all the fullness of God**. **20** Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that

works in us, **21** to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

The Spreading of God's Word through the Gospel of the Kingdom

Pray for God's Word to Spread and Bear Fruit Everywhere

Isaiah 55:10-11 (NKJV)

10 "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, **11** So shall **My word** be that goes forth from My mouth; **It shall not return to Me void**, But **it shall accomplish what I please**, And **it shall prosper** in the thing for which I sent it.

Acts 6:7 (NKJV)

Then **the word of God spread**, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly **in Jerusalem**, and a great many of the **priests** were obedient to the faith.

Acts 12:24 (NKJV)

But **the word of God grew and multiplied**.

Acts 13:12 (NKJV)

Then the **proconsul** believed, when he saw what had been done, being astonished at the **teaching** of the Lord.

Acts 13:48 (NKJV)

Now when the **Gentiles** heard this, they were glad and **glorified the word** of the Lord. And as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed.

Acts 19:20 (NKJV)

So **the word** of the Lord **grew mightily and prevailed**.

Pray for God to Open Up Opportunities for the Gospel

Acts 14:27 (NKJV)

Now when they had come and gathered the church together, they reported all that God had done with them, and that **He** had **opened the door of faith** to the Gentiles.

1 Corinthians 16:9 (NKJV)

For a **great and effective door** has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

2 Corinthians 2:12 (NKJV)

Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach Christ's gospel, and **a door was opened** to me **by the Lord**,

Revelation 3:8 (NKJV)

"I know your works. See, I have **set before you an open door**, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

Colossians 4:2-4 (NKJV)

2 Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; **3** meanwhile praying also for us, **that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ**, for which I am also in chains, **4** that I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.

Philemon 6 (NKJV)

6 that **the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgement of every good thing which is in you** in Christ Jesus.

Pray for God to Open Hearts and Minds to HIS Word

2 Timothy 2:25-26 (NKJV)

25 in humility correcting those who are in opposition, **if God** perhaps **will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, 26** and that **they may come to their senses** and **escape the snare of the devil**, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

Acts 16:14 (NKJV)

Now a certain woman named Lydia heard us. She was a seller of purple from the city of Thyatira, who worshipped God. **The Lord opened her heart** to heed the things spoken by Paul.

Luke 24:45 (NKJV)

And **He opened their understanding**, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

Pray for the Release of Apostolic Workers to Help the Church to Mature

1 Thessalonians 3:9-13 (NKJV)

9 For what thanks can we render to God for you, for all the joy with which we rejoice for your sake before our God, **10** night and day praying exceedingly that we **may see your face** and **perfect what is lacking in your faith?** **11** Now may our God and Father Himself, and our Lord Jesus Christ, **direct our way to you. 12** And may the Lord **make you increase and abound in love** to one another and to all, just as we do to you, **13** so that He **may establish your hearts blameless in holiness** before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.

Pray for Workers to Be Equipped and Released for Harvest and Discipleship

Luke 10:2 (NKJV)

Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore **pray the Lord of the harvest** to send out laborers into His harvest.

Matthew 28:18-20 NKJV)

18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "**All authority has been given to Me** in heaven and on earth. **19 Go** therefore and **make disciples** of all the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20 teaching** them **to observe all things that I have commanded you**; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Romans 10:13-15 (NKJV)

13 For "**whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.**" **14 How** then shall they **call** on Him in whom they **have not believed**? And **how** shall they **believe** in Him of whom they **have not heard**? And **how** shall they **hear without a preacher**? **15** And **how** shall they **preach unless they are sent**? As it is written: "**How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!**"

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

But **you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you**; and **you shall be witnesses** to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

2 Timothy 2:1-2 (NKJV)

1 You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. **2** And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, **commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.**

***Pray for Workers and the Word They Preach to Spread
Quickly and Effectively***

2 Thessalonians 3:1-5 (NKJV)

1 Finally, brethren, pray for us, **that the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified**, just as it is with you, **2** and that we **may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith.** **3** But **the Lord is faithful**, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one. **4** And we have confidence in the Lord concerning you, both **that you do and will do the things we command you.** **5** Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ.

***Pray for Grace for Workers to Preach the Gospel with
Boldness and Depth***

Ephesians 6:19-20 (NKJV)

19 and for me, **that utterance may be given to me**, that I may **open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel**, **20** for which I am an ambassador in chains; **that in it I may speak boldly**, as I ought to speak.

2 Timothy 4:1-5 (NKJV)

1 I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: **2** **Preach the word!** Be ready in season and out of season. **Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.** **3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; **4** and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. **5** But you **be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.**

Pray for Protection and Open Doors for Workers

Romans 15:30-33 (NKJV)

30 Now I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, and through the love of the Spirit, that you **strive together** with me **in prayers** to God **for me, 31 that I may be delivered from those** in Judea **who do not believe**, and that **my service** for Jerusalem **may be acceptable to the saints, 32 that I may come to you** with joy by the will of God, and **may be refreshed together with you. 33** Now the God of peace be with you all. Amen.

Conviction, Repentance and Salvation

General

Acts 2:36-41 (NKJV)

36 “Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.” **37** Now when they heard this, **they were cut to the heart**, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Men and brethren, what shall we do?” **38** Then Peter said to them, “**Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins**; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **39** For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.” **40** And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, “**Be saved from this perverse generation.**” **41** Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

John 14:6 (NKJV)

Jesus said to him, “**I am the way, the truth, and the life.** No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Ephesians 4:18-21 (NKJV)

18 having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; **19** who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to

lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. **20** But you have not so learned Christ, **21** if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus:

2 Peter 3:9-10 (NKJV)

9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, **not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.** **10** But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.

1 Timothy 2:1-4 (NKJV)

1 Therefore I exhort first of all **that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life** in all godliness and reverence. **3** For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, **4** who **desires all men to be saved** and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Romans 1:20-21 (NKJV)

20 For since the creation of the world **His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made,** even His eternal power and Godhead, **so that they are without excuse, 21 because,** although **they knew God,** they **did not glorify Him as God,** nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Romans 3:23-25 (NKJV)

23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25** whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,

Isaiah 53:5-6 (NKJV)

5 But **He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And**

by His stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

John 15:22 (NKJV)

If I had not come and spoken to them, they would have no sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin.

Isaiah 55:1 (NKJV)

“Ho! **Everyone who thirsts**, Come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk Without money and without price.

Pray for Jews to Be Saved

Romans 10:1 (NKJV)

Brethren, my heart’s desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved.

Call Out Aloud in Public in Agreement with Wisdom

Proverbs 1:20-33 (NKJV)

20 Wisdom calls aloud outside; She raises her voice in the open squares. **21** She cries out in the chief concourses, At the openings of the gates in the city She speaks her words: **22** “How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? For scorners delight in their scorning, And fools hate knowledge. **23** Turn at my rebuke; Surely I will pour out my spirit on you; I will make my words known to you. **24** Because I have called and you refused, I have stretched out my hand and no one regarded, **25** Because you disdained all my counsel, And would have none of my rebuke, **26** I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your terror comes, **27** When your terror comes like a storm, And your destruction comes like a whirlwind, When distress and anguish come upon you. **28** “Then they will call on me, but I will not answer; They will seek me diligently, but they will not find me. **29** Because they hated knowledge

And did not choose the fear of the Lord, **30** They would have none of my counsel And despised my every rebuke. **31** Therefore they shall eat the fruit of their own way, And be filled to the full with their own fancies. **32** For the turning away of the simple will slay them, And the complacency of fools will destroy them; **33** But whoever listens to me will dwell safely, And will be secure, without fear of evil.”

Pray for Repentance

1 John 1:9 (NKJV)

If we confess our sins, **He is faithful and just to forgive** us our sins and **to cleanse** us from all unrighteousness.

Mark 1:15 (NKJV)

and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. **Repent, and believe in the gospel.**”

Luke 13:1-5 (NKJV)

1 There were present at that season some who told Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. **2** And Jesus answered and said to them, “Do you suppose that these Galileans were worse sinners than all other Galileans, because they suffered such things? **3** I tell you, no; but **unless you repent you will all likewise perish.** **4** Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them, do you think that they were worse sinners than all other men who dwelt in Jerusalem? **5** I tell you, no; but **unless you repent you will all likewise perish.**”

Spiritual Renewal, Awakening, Revival and Restoration

General

Ezekiel 36:26 (NKJV)

I will give you a **new heart** and put a **new spirit** within you; I will **take the heart of stone out** of your flesh and give you a **heart of flesh**

Revelation 3:20 (NKJV)

“Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.”

Isaiah 44:3 (NKJV)

For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, And floods on the dry ground; I will pour My Spirit on your descendants, And My blessing on your offspring;

Psalms 85:6 (NKJV)

Will You not revive us again, That Your people may rejoice in You?

Ephesians 5:14 (NKJV)

Therefore He says: “Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light.”

Ezekiel 37:4-14 (NKJV)

4 Again He said to me, “Prophesy to these bones, and say to them, ‘**O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! 5 Thus says the Lord God to these bones: “Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. 6 I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I am the Lord.”**’ ” **7** So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone. **8** Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but there was no breath in them. **9** Also He said to me, “Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, ‘**Thus says the Lord God: “Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live.”**’ ” **10** So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army. **11** Then He said to me, “Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, ‘Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!’ **12** Therefore prophesy and say to them, ‘**Thus says the Lord God: “Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you**

to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. **13** Then you shall know that I am the Lord, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves. **14** I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the Lord, have spoken it and performed it," says the Lord.' "

***Pray for GOD to Manifest, Shake Resistance and Restore
Calling on HIS Name***

Isaiah 64:1-7 (NKJV)

1 Oh, that You would **rend the heavens!** That You would **come down!** That the mountains might shake at Your presence— **2** As fire burns brushwood, As fire causes water to boil— To **make Your name known to Your adversaries,** That the nations may tremble at Your presence! **3** When You did awesome things for which we did not look, You came down, The mountains shook at Your presence. **4** For since the beginning of the world Men have not heard nor perceived by the ear, Nor has the eye seen any God besides You, Who acts for the one who waits for Him. **5** You meet him who rejoices and does righteousness, Who remembers You in Your ways. You are indeed angry, for we have sinned— In these ways we continue; And we need to be saved. **6** But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away. **7** **And there is no one who calls on Your name,** Who stirs himself up to take hold of You; For You have hidden Your face from us, And have consumed us because of our iniquities.

***Pray for the Outpouring of the HOLY SPIRIT to Bring
Revelation and Revival***

Acts 2:17-21 (NKJV)

17 'And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That **I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall**

dream dreams. **18** And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy. **19** I will show wonders in heaven above And signs in the earth beneath: Blood and fire and vapor of smoke. **20** The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord. **21** And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of the Lord Shall be saved.'

***Pray for Boldness to Speak the Word in the Midst of
Opposition or Persecution***

Romans 1:16 (NKJV)

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

Acts 4:23-31 (NKJV)

23 And being let go, they went to their own companions and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said to them. **24** So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God with one accord and said: "**Lord, You are God, who made heaven and earth and the sea, and all that is in them,** **25** who by the mouth of Your servant David have said: '**Why did the nations rage, And the people plot vain things? 26 The kings of the earth took their stand, And the rulers were gathered together Against the Lord and against His Christ.**' **27** "For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together **28** to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose determined before to be done. **29** Now, Lord, look on their threats, and **grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.**" **31** And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Pray for the Inheritance of Jesus to be Secured Regardless of Opposition

Psalm 2 (NKJV)

1 Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing? **2** The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying, **3** “Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us.” **4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The Lord shall hold them in derision. 5** Then **He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure: 6** “Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion.” **7** “I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. **8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession. 9** You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter’s vessel.’” **10** Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth. **11** Serve the Lord with fear, And rejoice with trembling. **12** Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.

Pray the Model Prayer

Matthew 6:9-15 (NKJV)

9 In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. **10** Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven. **11** Give us this day our daily bread. **12** And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. **13** And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen. **14** “For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. **15** But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

***Pray for and Call the Church, God's House, the New
Jerusalem to be Glorified***

Isaiah 60 (NKJV)

1 Arise, shine; For your light has come! Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. **13** Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. **14** But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

2 Corinthians 10:3-4 (NKJV)

3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. **4** For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,

Sanctification and Maturity of Believers

General

2 Corinthians 13:7-9 (NKJV)

7 Now I pray to God that you do no evil, not that we should appear approved, but that you should do what is honorable, though we may seem disqualified. **8** For we can do nothing against the truth, but for the truth. **9** For we are glad when we are weak and you are strong. And this also we pray, that you may be made complete.

1 Thessalonians 4:4, 7 (NKJV)

4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,
7 For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

Jeremiah 42:2-3 (NKJV)

2 and said to Jeremiah the prophet, “Please, let our petition be acceptable to you, and pray for us to the Lord your God, for all this remnant (since we are left but a few of many, as you can see), **3** that the Lord your God may **show us the way in which we should walk and the thing we should do.**”

3 John 2 (NKJV)

Beloved, I pray **that you may prosper in all things and be in health,** just as your soul prospers.

Philippians 2:5-8 (NKJV)

5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, **6** who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, **7** but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. **8** And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

1 Peter 2:13-15 (NKJV)

13 Therefore submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord’s sake, whether to the king as supreme, **14** or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and for the praise of those who do good. **15** For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men—

Matthew 25:34-36 (NKJV)

Pray for Love to Increase Resulting in Discernment and Righteousness

Philippians 1:9-11 (NKJV)

9 And this I pray, that your **love may abound still more and more** in knowledge and all discernment, **10 that you may approve** the things that are excellent, that you **may be sincere and without offense** till the day of Christ, **11** being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

Pray for Maturity to Bear Fruit (Goodness) and to Operate in Power

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 (NKJV)

11 Therefore we also pray always for you that our God **would count you worthy of this calling**, and **fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness** and the **work of faith with power**, **12 that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified** in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Pray for the Full Sanctification of Spirit, Soul, and Body

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 (NKJV)

23 Now may the God of peace Himself **sanctify you completely**; and may **your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless** at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. **24** He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.

Unity and Love Among Believers

Pray for Unity Among Believers and for Joy and Peace in Believing

Romans 15:5-7, 13 (NKJV)

5 Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, **6** that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. **7** Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God. **13** Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Pray for Protection, Oneness with God and One Another and Sanctification

John 17:9-26 (NKJV)

9 "I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. **10** And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them. **11** Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, **keep through Your name** those whom You have given Me, **that they may be one as We are.** **12** While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. **13** But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, **that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.** **14** I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **15** I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but **that You should keep them from the evil one.** **16** They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **17 Sanctify them by Your truth.** Your word is truth. **18** As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. **19** And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth. **20** "I do not **pray for these**

alone, but also for **those who will believe** in Me through their word; **21 that they all may be one**, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; **that they also may be one in Us**, that the world may believe that You sent Me. **22** And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, **that they may be one just as We are one**: **23** I in them, and You in Me; **that they may be made perfect in one**, and **that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me**. **24** “Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me **may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory** which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world. **25** O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me. **26** And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, **that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them.**”

Pray for the Relationships within the Body of CHRIST

Ephesians 4:25-27 (NKJV)

25 Therefore, putting away lying, “Let each one of you **speak truth with his neighbor**,” for we are members of one another. **26** “**Be angry, and do not sin**”: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, **27** nor give place to the devil.

John 13:34-35 (NKJV)

34 A new commandment I give to you, that you **love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another**. **35** **By this all will know that you are My disciples**, if you have love for one another.”

Colossians 3:12-15 (NKJV)

12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, **put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering**; **13** **bearing with one another, and forgiving one another**, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. **14** But above all these things **put on love**, which is the bond of perfection. **15** And **let the peace of God rule in your hearts**, to which also you were called in one body; and **be thankful**.

Psalm 133:1 (NKJV)

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity!

The Gifts and Power of the Holy Spirit

Pray for Grace to be Enriched in All Gifts and for Strength to Overcome

1 Corinthians 1:4-9 (NET)

4 I always thank my God for you **because of the grace** of God that was given to you in Christ Jesus. **5** For **you were made rich** in every way in him, in all your speech and in every kind of knowledge— **6** just as the testimony about Christ has been confirmed among you— **7** so that you do **not lack any spiritual gift** as you wait for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ. **8** **He will also strengthen you to the end**, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. **9** God is faithful, by whom you were called into fellowship with his son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

Pray for Spiritual Gifts with Love as the Motive

1 Corinthians 12:31-13:3 (NKJV)

12:31 But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.

13:1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. **2** And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. **3** And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.

1 Corinthians 14:1 (NKJV)

Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.

1 Corinthians 14:39 (NKJV)

Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues.

Pray for the Release of the HOLY SPIRIT' Power to those who Wait on GOD

Luke 24:49 (NKJV)

Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but **tarry** in the city of Jerusalem **until** you are endued with **power** from on high.”

Pray for the Baptism with the Holy Spirit

Luke 11:13 (NKJV)

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father **give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!**”

Pray for All the Gifts to Function in the Body

1 Corinthians 12:4-7 (NKJV)

4 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. **5** There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. **6** And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. **7** But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:

Good Parenting Among Believers and Believing Youth

Jeremiah 1:6-8 (NKJV)

6 Then said I: “Ah, Lord God! Behold, I cannot speak, for I am a youth.”

7 But the Lord said to me: “Do not say, ‘I am a youth,’ For you shall go to all to whom I send you, And whatever I command you, you shall speak. **8** Do not be afraid of their faces, For I am with you to deliver you,” says the Lord.

Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV)

Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.

Matthew 18:5-6 (NKJV)

5 Whoever receives one little child like this in My name receives Me. **6** “But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to sin, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were drowned in the depth of the sea.
